Two out-of-state health systems are seeking to acquire Minnesota hospitals our communities depend on. **Sanford Health** wants to acquire **North Memorial Health**, and **Sutter Health** wants to acquire **Allina Health**.

OUR CARE IS ON THE LINE.

These deals could reshape where we get care, what it costs, and who makes decisions about the hospitals and clinics we depend on. No one should have to...

For example, Sutter Health acquired hospitals in Northern California, where it now dominates the market. Now, patients pay 70% more for hospital stays than patients in Southern California.
